Health Nugget

A study was done on 700 elderly women ages 70-79 to examine the relationship between fruit and vegetable intake, physical activity, and all-cause mortality in older women. "Total serum carotenoids, a marker of fruit and vegetable intake, and physical activity were measured at baseline. Physical activity was measured according to kilocalorie expenditure." The study was done in Baltimore, Maryland. The women were followed for 5 years, and in that time 11.5% of the participants died. "The combination of low total serum carotenoids and low physical activity, both modifiable risk factors, strongly predicted earlier mortality. These findings provide preliminary support that higher fruit and vegetable intake and exercise improve survival."
